Author's Guidelines

Manuscript must be written on A-4 size paper with 2.00 cm. or 1 inch margin all around, with 12 font size (times new roman), 1.5 spaced in English and should be submitted via email at jips.gnacollege2016@gmail.com or molbio.vinod@gmail.com manuscript.html jointly with covering letter from corresponding author as a file saved in MS Word (.doc) or pdf format. Before submitting spelling, punctuation, sentence structure, italic words and spacing should be properly checked.

Journal of Innovative Prospective in Sciences intend to publish verification based scientific research articles from various disciplines of Science, Engineering, Technology and Agriculture fields. The Journals welcome articles of general interest to the researchers, academicians and students.

Please submit a single word (.doc/ .dox. PDF) version of your manuscript (in soft copy) that include all tables and figures, images at appropriate location. All pages should be numbered successively opening from title page. The file name should contain the name of corresponding author and a keyword from the title of your manuscript.

Manuscript should be in following sequence:

- Title page
- Authors details
- Abstract
- Keywords
- Introduction
- Materials and Methods
- Results and Discussion
- Acknowledgements
- References

Title page: Title page should contain the title of the article, names of all authors, their institutional affiliations. The name of corresponding author should be clearly marked by (*) or (**) etc. and his/her full postal address with city, Pin code and country, telephone number and email address should be clearly mentioned.

Abstract: Abstract should be concise not more than 250 words describing purpose, methods, important results and derived conclusion of the study.

Keywords: 3 to 6 keywords characterizing the scope of the article and central aspect of the work.

Introduction: The introduction should clearly indicate the aim of the study and necessary back ground information. The precise problems that the author mainly likes to solve during study should also be stated. Unnecessary and excessive explanation makes the introduction bulky.

Materials and Methods: The clarification of the experimental methods should be short and sufficient for repetition by other investigators. Protocols/ procedures that have been published earlier should not be described in detail. Sources and grades of chemicals and materials, and

make of equipment used during investigation should be indicated. Methods of statistical analysis and type should be described.

Tables and figures: All the tables and figures should be numbered successively and titled rightfully that can explain the content and nature of the table and figures. Tables and figures should be cited at appropriate locations for correct account.

Results and Discussion: It should enclose the scientific interpretation of result and justifications of research. It should also include the key conclusion drawn from results and its contribution to people.

Acknowledgement should be written before References and after the Results and Discussion.

References/ Bibliography at the end of the research/ review papers must be listed in the Alphabetical orders and will be given in the text by the Author name/s, Year of the publication, Title of the paper/ Chapter of Book if any, name of the Journal/ Publication, Volume, Number and Page number in following format.
